

Ten Years of Inclusive Sustainable Development

The KIDDP programme is aimed at converting into financial resources for development 44 million Euros from the eligible Official Development Assistance (ODA) debt owed by the Kenyan Government to the Italian Government.



Management and monitoring are provided through three mixed Kenyan-Italian bodies:

- The **Steering Committee** which is in charge of approval of the initiative and fund allocation;
- The **National Technical Committee** in charge of evaluating proposals and monitoring activities;
- The **Secretariat** provides technical support

The funds are channeled through the Kenyan Government ministries of national and county level, which are in charge of the implementation following national procedures

KENYA - ITALY DEBT FOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

With a specific pro-poor focus, the targeted areas of Kenya have been the most remote and disadvantaged locations.

All KIDDP initiatives spark from community or local government proposals and tackle their specific needs for:

- education (vocational training)
- health
- water and irrigation
- urban slum upgrading



Ten years later, the 44 million Euros have been used to assist Kenya in its fight against poverty through a better delivery of basic services.



With 123 projects, KIDDP is now active in 26 counties.



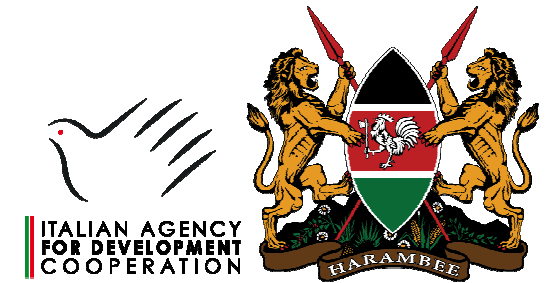

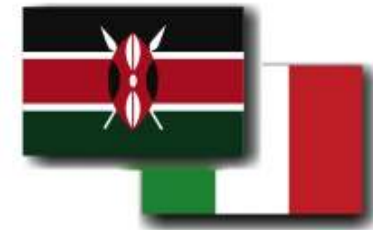
