2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I am writing to you to see if I can apply for focusing on only 2 or 3 pilot actions on Lot 1, instead of 4 MC and 1 NC? What is the minimum number of pilot action per proposal? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to section 1.2 – Objectives of the programme and priority issues of the Guidelines for grant applicant Naturalbania: “The Call for Proposals is divided into two lots: Lot 1: Pilot Actions in the Mountain-Countryside context and Natural Capital Lot 2: Pilot Actions in the Coast - Sea context Each lot contains a set of specific priority issues to be targeted. Lot 1: Pilot Actions in the Mountain-Countryside context and Natural Capital The specific priorities of this lot are: realization of four pilot actions with local communities, linking ecosystems and enhancing protected mountain areas and ecological corridors, in the sectors of sustainable tourism, environmental protection and sustainability, promotion of local

products;
realization of one pilot action for the economic evaluation of the natural capital of protected areas.

Lot 2: Pilot Actions in the Coast - Sea context

The specific priorities of this lot are:
realization of five pilot actions with the local communities, linking ecosystems and enhancing the coastal ecosystems and the marine environment, in order to integrate environmental and biodiversity protection actions with the development of historical, cultural and traditional aspects of sustainable local tourism;”

Hence, for each lot the specific priorities consist in the realization of all five actions addressed. As consequence, the minimum number of pilot actions per proposal is five.
